School Sport Premium expenditure 2013-2014 (£9,770)

The leasing of a school mini-bus in 2013 has meant that we can now involve our children in as many competitions as possible. We believe this is important not only for the development of sporting skills but to help boost confidence, raise self-esteem and generate the pride that comes with representing your school. **In 2013/14** these have included tennis, athletics, netball, football and multi-skills for targeted children in KS2 and KS1. In addition we have strong ties with the local professional rugby organisations and compete in their tag rugby events throughout the year.

The minibus is enabling us to access the swimming pool twice a week for lessons.

We have employed the services of a member of the PE staff from Leeds West Academy, our local High School, to work with our children in Year 6 for an afternoon a week. His involvement is a big boost to our transition programme as well as enabling the children to experience alternative sports. This has also supported staff professional development.

We have paid for support from the local authority which has boosted staff CPD.

Contribution from the grant to the revamping of our playground with the introduction of a Multi Games Area (MUGA) and new playground markings has significantly improved provision for our pupils who do not have access to a games field. Two classes at a time can now enjoy quality PE. In addition pupils have much more active playtimes with the opportunity to participate in more structured activities because of this quality all weather surface.
