The school will do its best to:

- Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection;
- Adhere to the social distancing rules as set out by the government as much as we reasonably can:
- Provide a curriculum that meets the needs of your child's well-being, mental health and academic needs:
- Contact parents/carers if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19;
- Inform you if staff or children in your child's 'bubble' tests positive for COVID-19 as this will mean you will all need to self-isolate for at least 14 days;
- Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in the Behaviour Policy as well as the expectations outlined in this agreement;
- Communicate between home and school through Seesaw, text, email and the school website.

To help my child at school, I know and understand that:

- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19: I will not send them to school; we will self-isolate for 14 days as a family; I will get them tested and I will let the school know as soon as possible via telephone;
- If my child displays COVID-19 symptoms in school, I will collect them from school immediately;
- If the school informs me that a member of my child's bubble has tested positive for COVID-19, I will collect my child immediately and isolate at home for 14 days:
- On my commute, and when dropping my child off and picking them up, I will adhere to the 2 metre social distancing rules;
- When dropping off and picking up, I will strictly stick to the school timings for my child;
- My child must not bring any items into school with them or take items home from school:
- I will need to remind my child about social distancing rules but accept they are difficult to follow and that my child may not always do this successfully;
- My child will need to use good respiratory and hand hygiene (catch it- bin it- kill it);
- I will not be allowed into the school but can request to speak to someone via telephone or email;
- I need to support all staff in their efforts to create an 'as safe as possible' environment during the pandemic;
- I will read all letters/messages that are sent home;
- I need to inform the school immediately of any changes to parents/carer and emergency contact details;
- I will work with the school if my child's behaviour puts others at risk.

Child

I will do my best to:

- Adhere to the social distancing rules in class and in the playground;
- Tell an adult if I feel unwell:
- Not bring things into school from home, or take things home from school;
- Only use the equipment provided to me by school and no other;
- Not mix with any other children in the other groups in school;
- Only enter and exit the school building from the designated gate and door:
- Follow good respiratory hygiene: coughing and sneezing into my elbow or a tissue (catch it - bin it - kill it);
- Follow good hand hygiene use soap and water for 20 seconds/hand sanitiser;
- Behave well at all times to maintain the safety of myself and others;
- Follow these expectations and know that if I don't, my parents will be contacted and a plan put in place to ensure everyone is safe.
