**The Raynville Academy uniform is:**

Plain, grey school trousers

Plain, grey school skirts/pinafore dress

Summer – plain grey shorts or red check summer dresses

Polo shirt white, either with school logo or plain

Sweatshirt red, either with school logo or plain or Cardigan

Socks/Tights plain please

Footwear should be plain and black.



Jewellery is not permitted, apart from stud earrings. Children must be able to tape up or remove their own earrings for PE for health and safety reasons. Make-up it is not necessary for children to wear make-up. Hair hairstyles must not be extreme and only natural hair colours are permissible.
