As part of our topic on Rivers we have arranged a fieldtrip to White Scar Cave in Ingleton on Wednesday February 16th to study the features of a river and the ways in which rivers affect the landscape. This is a fantastic trip in the longest show cave in England which allows children to see underground streams and waterfalls, flowstone, prehistoric mud pools, and the huge Battlefield Cavern adorned with thousands of stalactites.

We would ask parents to pay a voluntary contribution of £14 towards the cost of the visit. This can be paid on your ParentPay account. Unfortunately, if we do not receive enough voluntary contributions to cover the cost of the visit it may have to be cancelled.

Children will need to be at school by 8.15 as we aim to be leaving school at 8.30am and hope to arrive back to school at 3.30pm.
