



Dear Parent,

As part of this term's Local History topic, we have arranged a visit to the Victorian Schoolroom at Armley Mills on **Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> May 2022**. The children, dressed in period costume, will experience a typical Victorian school day and take part in the Mill Workshop.

We shall be travelling by minibus, leaving school at 9.15 a.m. and returning for 3.15 p.m.

The children will need to arrive at school dressed in their Victorian costumes:

Boys	Girls
Long dark school trousers	Dark knee socks or tights
Long woollen socks (worn over trousers)	Black shoes, black boots, black pumps.
Black shoes, black boots, black pumps.	Plain dark dress or skirt and dark top
White shirt with stiff collar or no collar	Shawl (optional)
Short scarf/flat cap	Hair tied back with ribbons or in plaits or ringlets
A dark waistcoat will be provided by Armley Mills	A white smock will be provided by Armley Mills

Each child will need to bring a packed lunch. If your child is entitled to a Free Meal, school will provide a packed lunch for your child on the day.
