



Dear Parent /Carer.

Liverpool Visit Thursday 23rd June 2022

As part of our study about Life in the Sixties and our future geography topic about Liverpool we have arranged to visit Liverpool on the above date.

We will be visiting The Beatles Story which is an interactive museum that will take the children on an enlightening and atmospheric journey into the life, times, culture and music of The Beatles. We will pass Albert Dock and then walk, passing many historic buildings, to the Pier Head where we will take the famous River Mersey Explorer Cruise to see how Liverpool grew as a port and see the skyline from the river. The children will also have an audio commentary about the History of Liverpool. Afterwards we will visit the Liverpool Museum to see the actual size of the Liver Birds, then we will visit the Maritime Museum to see a model of the Titanic before making our way back to Albert Dock. The children will need to be at school for 7.15 am and will be returning to school at approx. 5.30pm. We would ask that parents pay a voluntary contribution of £15 to cover the cost of this visit. It is important that parents return the slip by this deadline otherwise we may not be able to provide your child with a packed lunch.

If your child suffers from travel sickness, please ensure you give your child a tablet before setting off and make sure a member of staff is given tablets for the return journey. Please complete the permission slip below and return to school.
