This is designed to give you some information about your child going into our year 4 classes next year.

3K move to 4R – Miss Ridley who is working with Mrs Keating.

3MK move to 4K – Mrs Kitchen who is working with Mrs Kemble.

These classes line up in the KS2 playground in a morning and leave by the KS2 playground.

Here are some of the things to be aware of going into year 4 -

-  When it is poor weather before school, we try to open the KS2 hall for the older children as they are often unaccompanied in a morning.
-  The year 4 children regularly attend assemblies with a focus on morals, attendance and rewarding good work/behaviour.
-  Reading at home with your child is **VERY** important to their development – please help.
-  By the end of year 4, children are expected to know ALL the times tables up to 12– not just to recite them. Please support them at home with this this – they now have a national test at the end of year 4!
-  Some children may start swimming lessons as the year 5s finish
