Children’s Mobile Phone Permission

Children should only bring their phones into school if they are walking to or from school alone and they need to have them in case of an emergency. If your child fits the above criteria, could you please sign and return the slip below to indicate that due to safety reasons, you wish your child to bring a phone into school.

Please note that your child will need to switch his/her phone off completely before entering the playground and will need to hand their phones into a designated member of staff at the beginning of the school day. The phones will be kept in the school office during the day, to ensure that they are kept safe and this will avoid them being lost or damaged.

Please supply a named plastic bag for your child’s mobile phone (so we know which phone belongs to which child).
