We are very excited be learning about a variety of topics this half term and we continue to work hard as we prepare for SATs.

THIS HALF TERM'S LEARNING

Maths:

In maths we will be looking at the place value of decimals. We will use this understanding to add, subtract, multiply and divide decimals.

We will then move on to looking at fractions, decimals and percentages.

We will use our arithmetic lessons to consolidate our work on fractions from last half term. We are celebrating Number Day on Friday 3rd February. This will be an exciting maths themed day where we will also re-launch Times Table Rock Stars. Children are encouraged to dress up as rock stars for that day.

English:

This half-term we will be basing our work around the book Wonder by RJ Palacio. We will be focusing on how to write a balanced argument, which will involve a lot of debating and skilled speaking. The children will also be learning how to write an emotive piece of work and a persuasive letter.

Work will also involve focused sessions on spelling punctuation and grammar.

VIPERS

In our reading vipers lessons, we will be developing our vocabulary, inference, prediction, retrieval skills

PE:

Children will be having PE on a Wednesday.
This half term we will be developing our gymnastic skills involving cannoning and symmetry.

PSHCF.

Our unit is 'How can we keep healthy as we grow?' During this unit we will look at what physical and mental health means and how we can look after both of these areas of health. We will share strategies for supporting our mental health such as having forming positive friendships, being involved in activities and explore how we can improve our diet, physical activity and sleep.

MFL:

This half term we will be finishing off the work we have done on classroom objects. We will also revise basic phrases learned last year.

We are going to start work on Mi Casa (MY home) focusing on which rooms are in the house.

History/Geography

This half term the focus is on Geography. We are looking at rivers and the journey a river makes to the ocean. We will be thinking about the 3
