# World Book Day

Dear parent/carer,

On Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2023 we will be celebrating World Book Day! Here is how we will be celebrating.

## **Vocabulary Parade**

The children can come to school dressed as a word linked to books or characters. When asked, children should be able to say what word they are. This could be (but not limited to):

• **Dress as a colour**: dress in different shades of one colour but discuss with your child the different words they could describe themselves as e.g. red could be scarlet, crimson, ruby, vermilion etc.

- Dress as a villain to represent: malevolent, vengeful, venomous etc.
- Dress as a wild animal to represent: predator, ferocious, savage etc.
- Dress as a king or queen to represent: majestic, royal, regal etc.
- Dress as a feeling: envy, suspicion, excited, happiness etc.
- Dress as a science word: children could be prey, evergreen, fossil, winter, float etc.

For further ideas you may wish to google 'vocabulary parade'.

### Book in a Box Competition

This year we will be running a 'Book in a Box' competition. We would love for our families to get creative this World Book Day by making a scene from a book in any box. Please bring these to school by Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> March and we will choose one winner from each year group the following day. The winners will receive a special prize! ### **Book Giveaway**
