



Dear Parents/Carers

We have arranged a visit for Year 4 to the Yorkshire Museum of Farming at Murton Park near York. This visit will form a very important part of our topic work on the Romans and we would like all the children to take part. During their day, the children will be taken back in time to experience a typical day in the life of a Roman soldier, dressing in costume and training to guard the fort.

The visit will take place on Monday 15th May and the children will need to be at school by 8.30am so that the coach can leave promptly at 8.45am. There will be a late return to school; we should arrive back around 4.15pm depending on traffic.

The children do not need to wear school uniform, but they must be appropriately dressed to be outdoors all day, and they should wear sensible footwear. Trainers or boots are the most suitable as the paths are stony. It would also be advisable to bring a waterproof coat.

Each child will need to bring a packed lunch. If your child is entitled to Free School Meals, a packed lunch will be provided on the day.

**The voluntary cost of the trip is £10.00, which includes transport and entry into the village. School is subsidising the actual cost in order to keep the price to a minimum.** Please return permission slips to school and make your payment on your Arbor account.
