THIS HALF TERM'S LEARNING			
<p>MATHS: We will continue our learning about Multiplication and Division. The children will be counting equal groups of objects in 2s 5s and 10s. Then we will be exploring the matching multiplication and division facts. Then the children will develop their knowledge of fractions as we split amounts into equal groups.</p>		<p>English: This half term we are looking at History sources to find out about significant people. We will focus on researching facts & writing instructions. Phonics: All the children will continue to develop their fluency in reading during daily Phonics sessions. They will also apply their phonic knowledge in daily writing tasks.</p>	
		<p>PE: Children will be having PE on a Tuesday and a Friday. They can come to school ready in their PE kits. This half term we will be focusing on Dance and Ball Skills.</p>	
<p>History: We are using our History detective skills to find information from different sources. We will be making comparisons between modern hospitals and hospitals in the past.</p>		<p>Science: Our Science topic teaches children about how living things change as they grow. We will be matching animals with their young & identifying what Humans need to stay healthy.</p>	
			
		<p>PSHCE: Our unit this half term allows pupils to develop their understanding of keeping safe. We will be looking at staying safe at home & staying safe online.</p>	
<p>How parents can help at home: Reading really accelerates children's writing so please read as often as possible at home. All pupils will bring home a reading book linked to their Phonics skills. If you visit the library & your child also reads books of their own choosing feel free to record this in their reading diary. Remember you can also practice your Maths skills on Numbots.</p>
