MATHS: Fractions (tenths, fractions of a set of objects, equivalent fractions, compare, order, add and subtract) Time (to the nearest minute, a.m, p.m, 24-hour clock) . Continuing to learn times tables (2, 3, 4, 5, 8, 10)	English: We will be reading the book "Leon and the Place Between" to write character descriptions and a persuasive poster for a magic show. VIPERS In our reading vipers lessons, we will be developing our vocabulary, inference, prediction, retrieval skills	
PE: Children will be having PE on a Monday. The children will learn how to play cricket and they will be working on their fitness.	PSHCE: The children will learn about eating well and the importance of looking after their teeth.	MFL: This half term we will learn the names of musical instruments.
History: Children will be learning about what life was like in prehistoric times focusing on the Stone Age to Iron Age.	Science: The children will learn the names of the different parts of a flowering plant and the life cycle of plants. We will investigate how water is transported around plants.
