



HALF TERM INFORMATION UPDATE


Reception

Message from the staff:

We cannot believe that this is our final half term! This year has flown by in the blink of an eye! As sad as we are to be saying goodbye to the reception children, we can see that they are almost ready for Year 1! This half term we will be preparing the children for their next stage at Raynville. They will meet their new teachers, spend some time in the new classrooms and play in the playground with the soon-to-be Year 2 children. Our next topic in Reception is *Journeys*. We will be looking at different transport, how we get to various places and talking about going on holiday. We have lots to look forward to in the next half term, our Summer Disco, the Foundation Fun Day, and the Summer Fayre.


This half term's learning:

Mathematics:



This half term in Math's we will be learning about sharing, doubling and halving. We will also be doing lots with numbers to 20, ordering and making with Math's equipment etc... these new skills will then be put into practice with lots of problem solving e.g., Sam has 6 sweets and wants to share them with his friend. How many sweets will they both have?

Literacy:



Recently in Literacy we have introduced something called Drawing Club to our lessons. Your child may already have told you they went to drawing club today. It is a way of enabling the children to use their own imaginations and creativity to develop ideas from stories and short films. Every piece of work is original and unique. We have already seen positive results from this method and so will be continuing it next half term. The children will also learn lots of new vocabulary and use an action to demonstrate their understanding. We will take a variety of story books, traditional tales, and short films as our inspiration for this. Please encourage your





child to write and draw at home too.

Personal, social, and emotional development:



Our next 'Healthy Inside and Out' day will be focusing on solving problems and how to make things better, working with others and the importance of teamwork. We will be preparing the children for the move to Year 1, looking at how they have changed and celebrating their successes. We will spend some time talking about any concerns or worries they have about going to Year 1 and of course, things they are looking forward to.

It would be helpful if you practised these skills at home. Count objects accurately, touching each one as you say the next number, play sharing games with sweets, small toys etc... Talk about doubles and challenge them to show you how to double numbers with counters, pennies or pebbles etc...

Understanding of the World

This half term we will be learning about journeys. We will look at different types of transport and where different transport will take us. We will end our half term by looking at journeys the children taken. We will be asking for any previous holiday photographs so the children can talk about the different journeys and places they have visited.



In our outdoor area we will be looking at the similarities and differences between our natural world around us. We will learn about summer and begin to look for minibeasts. I'm sure we will find many little minibeasts in our outdoor area.





Expressive art and design:

In Music we are learning to play the glockenspiel to accompany a funk song adapted for children. We also appreciate other types of music each week. Children explain their preferences using some musical vocabulary.

In art the children are given free access to different kinds of paint every week. They can choose this option whenever they want. They also use chalk, pastels and other media. Paintings are celebrated on display in our art gallery in the art area.

It would be helpful you share your musical tastes with your child and explain why you like that style or artist. Also


Physical development:


This half term we will be focusing on games. The children will learn to take turns and work as part of a team to complete many different mini games.


Children will continue to have PE on Thursdays. Please make sure your child comes to school in appropriate footwear.
