# THIS HALF TERM'S LEARNING

## **MATHS:**

We will be learning about adding and subtracting with money and finding change, telling the time using analogue and digital clocks, 2D and 3D shapes and angles. Finally, we will be at Statistics reading graphs and charts.

## **English:**

We will be reading the classic book "The Wizard of Oz," and writing newspaper reports.

#### **VIPERS**

In our reading vipers lessons, we will be developing our vocabulary, inference, prediction, retrieval skills

#### PE:

Children will be having PE on a Monday.

The children will be focusing on track and field activities.

#### **PSHCE:**

The children will learn about the importance of a good night's sleep and keeping active.
