THIS HALF TERM'S LEARNING

MATHS:

We will be finishing our learning about decimals which the children have found quite tricky but have really impressed us all with their resilience. We will be moving on to learning about money, time, statistics, and shape. We will also be completing our Times Tables test in June so keep practicing at home and using times tables rockstars! We are so impressed with the children's attitudes to maths. Keep it up!

English:

In English, we will be doing some writing about stories from other cultures. This will include 'The Blind Man and the Hunter' and some writing about a short video called 'Zahra'.

VIPERS

In our reading vipers lessons, we will be developing our vocabulary, inference, prediction, retrieval and summarising skills.

PE:

Children will be having PE on a Thursday. This half term we will be developing our track and field skills.

PSHCE:

Our next unit will be looking at managing risk and keeping ourselves safe outside. This will be really useful learning to prepare for the summer holidays.

MFL:

In Spanish this term, we will be learning how to name our pets and ask and answer questions about them.

History/Geography

In History we are continuing to learn about the Romans and the spread of the Roman Empire

How parents can help at home:
