THIS HALF TERM'S LEARNING

MATHS:

We are extending our knowledge of place value to working with hundreds, tens and ones. We will begin to use formal written calculations when adding and subtracting. We will also recap the 2s, 5s and 10 times tables.

English:

We will be using the story of the Three Little Pigs to develop language and vocabulary. The children will write their own story using this as inspiration.

VIPERS

In our reading vipers lessons, we will be developing our vocabulary, inference, prediction, retrieval skills

PE:

Children will be having PE on a Monday and Wednesday afternoon. Children are to bring their PE kits to school to change into.

PSHCE:

Identifying strengths and setting goals and how to be a good friend.

MFL:

This half term we will begin to learn Spanish using Language Angels.

Geography

The children will learn about the local area and the physical and human features within Bramley.

Science –Light. The children will investigate and identify different light sources and shadows.

Music

The children will deepen their understanding of music through singing and playing the glockenspiel.
