<p><b>MATHS:</b> In Maths we will be looking at multiplication and division this half term. We will be focusing on learning our times tables and relevant division facts before moving on to more formal written methods for calculations. Any times tables practice at home will help your children a lot.</p>		<p><b>English:</b> This half-term we will be writing based on Greek myths, including creating our own amazing mythical beasts!</p> <p><b>Reading:</b> We will be working on our comprehension skills.</p>	
<p><b>PE:</b> PE is on Tuesdays and Wednesdays. This half term they will be working on netball skills and problem solving.</p>	<p><b>PSHE:</b> Our unit this half term is about relationships and how we treat each other with respect.</p>	<p><b>MFL:</b> We will continue to learn how to greet and introduce ourselves in Spanish, as well as learning numbers and colours.</p>	
<p><b>History</b> They will be learning about Ancient Greeks with a focus on their achievements and what life was like.</p>	<p><b>Science</b> We will be learning about Sound and how we hear.</p>	<p><b>Music</b> This half term we will be learning about musical structures.</p>	
<p><b>How parents can help at home:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Please try to find time to read with your child at least 3 times a week. Remember to sign the reading record.</li> <li>• Read stories/books to your child that they wouldn't be able to read to themselves. You can visit Bramley Library where you can borrow up to 20 books! (There are no late charges anymore.)</li> <li>• Help your child learn their spellings. There will be a test every fortnight (unless your child is in a phonics group).</li> <li>• Practise times tables. The children can use Time Table Rockstars and your child's login can be found in their reading diary.</li> <li>• Please label all uniform and PE kit. Now that the children are getting changed for PE, there is more risk of clothes getting lost.</li> </ul>
