## THIS HALF TERM'S LEARNING

### Maths:

In Maths, we will be continuing with fractions, then move on to converting units. We will still have weekly arithmetic lessons and tests to practice our skills.

# **English:**

In English we will be studying the book 'Goodnight Mister Tom' and using this to write descriptions, diary entries and letters. We will continue looking at 'Poppy Field' by Michael Morpurgo.

### **VIPERS**

In our reading VIPERS lessons, we will be developing our vocabulary, inference, prediction, retrieval skills and continue to apply these to comprehension activities.

#### PE:

Children will be having PE on a **Tuesday** and a **Friday**. Please ensure you have the correct kit on these days, and a filled water bottle.

### RE

In RE we are thinking about compassion and how this is shown across religions. We will also link examples of compassion shown by people in World War 2

### MFL:

This half term we are continuing with learning the vocabulary for the classroom as well as revising phrases and practicing how to ask and answer questions in Spanish.

# **History/Geography:**

This half term our History topic continues to look in more detail at the Second World War, thinking about causes, events in Britain during the war and the consequences for the country The work will build on the visit to Eden Camp.

### Science:

Our science topic this half term is electricity. We will be learning about simple circuits, including what the different parts are, and investigating the effectiveness of different conductors and insulators.

### Music:

In Music, we will be exploring how music connects us with our past.

### **PSHE:**

In PSHE we will continue looking at the Relationships which we will encounter in our lives.
