Here are some of the things to be aware of going into year 6 -

- SATs take place in May SATs Week 2023 is 13<sup>th</sup> 17<sup>th</sup> May. As such, it is important that no holidays are taken during this week. These are done with no pressure on the children and each year we keep improving our results. We will hold a meeting about SATs next year.
- Please make sure you look around high schools for next year and get your applications in before the deadline, 31st October 2023 (more info next year).
- The year 6 children all have jobs to help them learn about responsibilities.
- Reading at home is still very important in year 6 please help by questioning and discussing with your child what they are reading at least three times a week.
- Writing stamina will increase and the amount of work will develop.
- Year 6 have a number of reward trips after SATs that promote bonding and aim to prepare them for high school.
- PE kits Children need a plain white t-shirt & black shorts for PE and a black tracksuit for outdoor sessions. Trainers or pumps too. They bring these in a bag on the days they have PE.
