THIS HALF TERM'S LEARNING			
MATHS: Reading scales and measuring the mass of objects in grams and kilograms. Calculating with fractions to build on previous learning. Continuing to learn times tables (2, 3, 4, 5, 8, 10) and link these to division facts.		English: We will be reading the book "Leon and the Place Between" to write our own magical stories. VIPERS In our reading vipers lessons, we will be developing our vocabulary, inference, prediction, retrieval skills using the text Stone Age Boy by Satoshi Kitamura.	
PE: Mondays and Wednesdays are PE days for Y3. The children can now come to school wearing their PE kits. The children will learn how to play cricket and they will be working on their fitness.	PSHCE: The children will learn about eating well and the importance of looking after their teeth.	MFL: This half term we will learn the names of musical instruments.	
History: Children will be learning about what life was like in prehistoric times focusing on the Stone Age to Iron Age.	Science: The children will learn the names of the different parts of a flowering plant and the life cycle of plants. We will investigate how water is transported around plants.	Music: Using your own imagination to compose your own pieces of music.

If your child gets spellings, please can they practice these several times. Visit Bramley Library and borrow any books of your choosing.
