## THIS HALF TERM'S LEARNING

#### **MATHS:**

In maths we will be looking at place value within 100. We will work on our number formations and look at partitioning numbers using tens and ones. We also look at estimating numbers on a number line.

We will then move on to addition and subtraction withing 100. Children will learn a range of methods to solve calculations involving 2-digit numbers. They will have access to a variety of resources to support them with their learning.


### **English:**

Our topic in English this half-term will be 'Go Jetters'. Children will learn facts about different landmarks around the world and begin writing their own fact files. To help them remember facts, we will be learning story maps and creating actions to match key words.

Handwriting will be a big focus this year. Please support your child at home by ensuring their letters are formed correctly and are of the right size. (especially 'b' and 'd'.)

#### **Phonics:**

All the children will continue to develop their fluency in reading during daily Phonics sessions. They will also apply their phonic knowledge in daily writing tasks.



#### PE:

Children will be having PE on Mondays and Tuesdays. They must come to school in their uniform and bring their P.E. kit with them. They will get changed in school before the lesson starts.



### **History:**

We are learning about how schools were different in the past. We will compare school life with today and discuss which we would prefer and why. We will be looking at a range of different sources to gather information.

### Science:

Our science topic teaches the children different materials. We will compare the properties of materials by carrying out simple investigations.

### **PSHCE:**

Our unit this half term allows pupils to develop their understanding of friendships. We will be looking at what makes a good friend, how different situations make us feel and how we can manage our emotions.





### How parents can help at home:

Reading really accelerates children's writing so please read as often as possible at home (At least 3 times per week). All pupils will bring home a reading book linked to their Phonics skills. If you visit the library & your child also reads books of their own choosing, feel free to record this in their reading diary.

Weekly spellings are uploaded on Seesaw to practice at home.

Practice Maths skills using Numbots: your child's login can be found in their reading diary.
